Application Criteria

Applicants **MUST** have participated in the GMFA programs as a player or volunteer and be enrolling in a post-secondary institution in the fall of 2024.

Application must be made in writing, and must include the following details:

- 1. Academic Standing provide a copy of your most recent transcript
- 2. Athletic Background
- 3. Financial Need
- 4. Community Involvement
- 5. Future Education Plans
- 6. Contact information, including Address, Phone Number and E-Mail Address
- 7. Letters of reference, including referee's name and address, from three (3) individuals who are not family members/relatives.

Submission Criteria

Application submissions **MUST** be received by the GMFA no later than **MARCH 31, 2024**.

Option #1 Electronic Submission: Email with attachments **received** no later than **March 31, 2024** before 11:59pm with **GMFA Scholarship Submission** in the subject line.
