This scholarship is in honour of Rob's passion for both hockey and continued education. This award provides the selected recipient with a one time \$500 scholarship to be used towards STEM related post-secondary education.

Eligibility

The *Rob McLure Memorial Scholarship* is intended for students who meet the following mandatory eligibility criteria;

- Grade 12 student and graduating in the current year of application.
- Enrolling in post secondary education in the current year of application in Engineering or other STEM fields.
- Played Hockey Canada sanctioned hockey in the current season.

Criteria & Submission Requirements

The applicant must provide documented proof that they meet the eligibility criteria. They must provide academic performance reports, proof of acceptance to post secondary education, letters of reference and any other additional supporting material to support their application as to why they deserve this scholarship. The information will be reviewed by the RMHC Executive Committee.

The criteria for review will include but may not be limited to:

- Eligibility, including a commitment to post secondary education.
- ✤ A 500-750 word essay on what hockey has meant to them.
- Future education plans and goals.
- Club and community volunteer contribution.
- Academic & athletic performance.
- Financial need
- Number of years of participation in RMHC
